Arrive safely and unload (there is plenty of secure trailer parking space)

10.00am Leave Furtho Manor farm

We start with a scenic village road run mainly on quiet country roads with some off road sections (well maintained tracks) to arrive at Lavendon miniature railway for morning coffee and cake. Here you can ride the train and view a collection of vehicles and aero plane cockpits.

You will then leave Lavendon at your leisure and continue on the route with guaranteed scenic countryside and quaint villages through rural Northamptonshire. We're heading to Orthingbury for a gathering of vintage tractors, steam engines and vehicles for a friendly BBQ lunch and refreshments.

After lunch we will meander through Northamptonshire and north Buckinghamshire countryside back to Furtho farm to conclude the day's event. This is about a 70 mile route of mainly flat terrain and quiet roads.

- Fuel stations are few and far between on route so a full spare fuel can is recommended for all cars.
